# City of Racine to Begin Demolition of Former YMCA Building at 725 Lake Avenue

Sledgehammer Ceremony Set for Monday, May 12 at Noon

RACINE, WI – The City of Racine will officially begin demolition of the former Racine Family YMCA building at 725 Lake Avenue on Monday, May 12. A Sledgehammer Ceremony will take place at 12:00 p.m., marking a major milestone in the City's ongoing effort to address public safety, eliminate blight, and prepare the lakefront site for future redevelopment.

Mayor Cory Mason and City officials will participate in a ceremonial "first swing" with a sledgehammer to kick off the demolition. Members of the public and media are invited to attend.

"The former YMCA building has been a long-standing safety concern and a barrier to progress on our lakefront," said Mayor Cory Mason. "While no formal redevelopment plans are in place yet, taking this structure down is a critical first step in returning this property to productive use. This is about improving safety and opening the door to future opportunities for our community."

The building, closed since 2019, had been on the market for years and steadily deteriorated despite community interest in its future. In 2023, the City's Community Development Authority (CDA) entered negotiations with the Racine Family YMCA and received public input during a CDA hearing. The Common Council approved the purchase in late 2023, and the CDA completed the acquisition of the property in 2024.

Following repeated concerns from building inspectors and public safety officials, the City prioritized demolition to address hazards posed by the abandoned structure. The work will be carried out by New Berlin Grading, with active demolition expected to continue for several weeks. Site grading and clean-up will follow, with all activity adhering to applicable safety and environmental standards.
