Mail Tax Payment and Coupon in Envelope to:

- You must endorse your two-party mortgage escrow check. Do not combine any other payments with your current property taxes. (This will significantly delay receipt of your taxes.)
- The amount **WRITTEN** on the pay line is considered to be the amount the check is for, not the amount in the courtesy box.
- To receive your receipt, please print a copy from the website.
- Tax Drop Box: There is a RED drop box outside of City Hall located at 730 Washington Ave. for City of Racine tax payments. No cash payments are accepted in the drop box.

Due Dates / Late Fees

The first installment is due **January 31**, **2026**.

If your tax bill qualifies and you choose to pay in installments, the remaining payments are due on March 31, May 31, and July 31, 2026.

Per state statute, If any installment is paid late, your payment plan is canceled. The entire remaining balance will then be considered delinquent and will accrue 1.5% interest and penalty per month (or part of a month) starting February 1 until the balance is paid in full.

Receipt Date

Your payment is considered received on the date it is processed by the Clerk's Office or the date of your credit card transaction.

Refunds

If no other taxes are due to the City of Racine or County of Racine, for a parcel owned by the same owner, LLC, or corporation, a refund will be issued.

- Refunds under \$10 must be picked up at the treasurer's office.
- Refunds \$10 and over will be mailed.

All refund checks will be **processed** about 8-10 weeks **after payment**.
