ON-SITE CASHLESS PAYMENT ONLY

Accepted:

- Tires: [\$8 per tire] no tractor tires, no rims
- Microwaves, TVs, and computers: [\$20 each]
- Non-Freon Appliances: [\$20 each] stove/range, washers, dryers, dishwashers, water heaters
- Freon Appliances: [\$30 each] refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers
- Household Bulky Items: [\$25 each] furniture, mattresses, box springs, bags of household trash, tied carpet rolls 4 feet in width or less

NOT Accepted:

• Concrete	• Metal	• Wood
• Construction Materials	• Toilets & Sinks	• Paint

March 7 – October 31:
7:45 a.m. to 5:45 p.m.

CLOSED HOLIDAYS

Accepted:

- Maximum 2 cubic yards of material
- Branches less than 6 inches in diameter

NOT Accepted:

- Branches over 6 inches in diameter, tree stumps, or root balls

No Dump Trucks, Dump Trailers, or Trailers longer than 8 feet at Pearl Street Drop-Off Site!

DROP-OFF SITES FOR CITY OF RACINE RESIDENTS ONLY:

Must show proof of residency with driver's license/photo ID and tax or utility bill with address.

Curbside Solid Waste (Black Cart)

Accepted:

- Mixed trash
- Food waste
- Non-recyclable plastics
- Styrofoam
- Broken toys
- Light Bulbs

NOT Accepted in Carts or Bags:

- Yard Waste
- Recyclables
- Concrete
- Construction Waste
- Batteries
- Electronics
- Oils/Liquids
- Paint

Note: Households may put up to three black 42-gallon bags next to full cart.

Curbside Recycling (Blue Cart)

Accepted:

- Tin, foil, steel, trays
- Empty aerosol cans
- Cardboard (broken down & bundled)
- Glass (clear, brown, and green)
- Plastics 1 – 5 and 7: 
- Envelopes
- Magazines & Books

Note: Households may put excess recyclables in clear blue bags next to full cart.

Household Bulky Items

What We Collect:

- Furniture, mattresses, and box springs
- Rolled carpet under 4 feet in width (tied)
- Items too large for cart

What We DO NOT Collect:

- Food Waste
- Appliances
- Electronics
- Tires
- Wood/Pallets
- Recyclables
- Yard Waste
- Construction Waste

Limits: Up to 5 pink-tagged items per week. No bulky collection on streets closed for construction.

- Put carts and bulky items out by 7 a.m. (or after 4 p.m. the previous day).

- Find your collection area (A-E) on the map to the right.
- On the calendar, look for your letter on each day—that's your trash day.
- When your area letter appears in your zone color, put out recycling too.
- There is no collection on designated holidays, which are marked in red on the calendar.


