CITY OF RACINE - 2026 AAP DRAFT PUBLIC NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING FY 2026 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

On or about Wednesday, June 10, 2026, the City of Racine will submit its FY 2026 Annual Action Plan (AAP) to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The AAP outlines the City's proposed use of federal funds, including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds, to address housing and community development needs identified in the 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan.

The City anticipates receiving the following federal funding for FY 2026:

- CDBG: \$1,711,710
- HOME: \$433,741.39
- ESG: \$153,237
- The City may also allocate program income and prior year resources, as applicable.

A **public comment period** of not less than 30 days will be held from May 5, 2026 through 5 p.m. on June 3, 2026.

A **public hearing** will be held on: Monday, May 11, 2026 at 4:30 p.m. in Room 303 of City Hall, 730 Washington Ave. Racine, WI 53403
