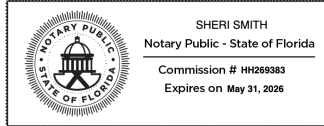

PUBLIC NOTICE OF NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY/ CITIZEN OUTREACH MEETING ON FY 2026 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

On or about Thursday, October 30, 2025, the City of Racine will release application materials for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME). These federal funds are allocated to the City of Racine by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to benefit persons and households with low and moderate incomes by providing safe and sanitary housing, suitable living environments, expanding economic opportunities, providing job training, improving neighborhood facilities/infrastructure, or other uses as defined in the 2025-2029 Con Plan.

Completed applications must be submitted no later than Saturday, November 30, 2025.

On Thursday, November 20, 2025, the City of Racine, Wisconsin will hold a Community Engagement Session at City Hall in reference to the City's 2026 Annual Action Plan (AAP). The AAP describes the City's proposed use for fiscal year (FY) 2026 available Federal and other resources to address the priority needs and specific objectives in the FY 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan (Con Plan); the City's method for distributing funds to City departments and non-profit organizations; and the geographic areas of the City to which it will direct assistance.

All interested parties are encouraged to join the Housing Division staff on Thursday, November 20, 2025, at City Hall 730 Washington Ave, Racine WI 53403 at 4 p.m. in room 303. The primary goal is to provide citizens--especially low and moderate-income citizens of the community where CDBG-funded activities will take place-- an opportunity to participate in an advisory role in the planning, implementation, and assessment of the programs and projects.
