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**Mayor Mason Proposes Renaming Cesar Chavez Community Center to
Dolores Huerta Community Center**

Racine, WI – Mayor Cory Mason today announced he is proposing that the Common Council consider renaming the Cesar Chavez Community Center, 2221 Douglas Avenue, to the Dolores Huerta Community Center.

"The recent allegations regarding Cesar Chavez are deeply troubling, and I believe they merit a serious response. I am proposing the council consider renaming the center in honor of Dolores Huerta, a remarkable leader whose own legacy of courage and service speaks for itself," said Mayor Mason.

Dolores Huerta co-founded the United Farm Workers alongside Cesar Chavez and spent decades organizing on behalf of farmworkers and Latino communities across the country. She is widely recognized as one of the most influential labor and civil rights leaders in American history, and her legacy reflects the strength and contributions of Latino women in that movement.

A resolution will be introduced at the next Common Council meeting on April 20, 2026.

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
